3. Please note 'under 10' means 'aged 10 and under'. (The same applies in all categories)
4. Candidates must qualify in age **on 8th May 2020**
5. An original copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator on the day of competition.
6. Candidates must register in the office thirty minutes before their competition is due to begin.
7. The closing date for receipt of music entries is **Friday 24th April**
8. The decision of the adjudicator is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Previous first prize winners may not compete in the same category again.
